An Act to Provide a Sales Tax Exemption for Materials Purchased by Certain Religious Institutions.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	36 MRSA §1760, sub-§65 is enacted to read:
5	65. Sales to monasteries. Sales of items for use in the
	<u>operation and maintenance of an incorporated nonprofit</u>
7	monastery. For the purpose of this subsection, "monastery" means
	the dwelling place of a community of religious persons.
