**An Act to Provide a Sales Tax Exemption for Materials Purchased by
Certain Religious Institutions.**



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **36 MRSA §1760, sub-§65** is enacted to read:

5 65. Sales to monasteries. Sales of items for use in the
7 operation and maintenance of an incorporated nonprofit
9 monastery. For the purpose of this subsection, "monastery" means
11 the dwelling place of a community of religious persons.

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 This bill provides a sales tax exemption to religious institutions known as monasteries.
