COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 98, L.D. 117, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Functions of Subregistrars"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§2844." in the first paragraph by inserting after the first sentence (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) the following underlined sentence 'Permits may be issued by a subregistrar only when the town or city clerk or deputy clerk is not available.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The original bill required that a municipal subregistrar who is authorized to issue permits dealing with the disposition of dead human bodies see that such permits are delivered to the municipal office as soon as that office is open.

This amendment allows the subregistrar only to issue such permits in the absence of the clerk. It is the intent of this amendment that those requiring these permits, insofar as possible, obtain them from the clerk during normal business hours.
