SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 100, L.D. 119, Bill, "An Act Relating to State Personnel Administration"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first paragraph after the title the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §7051, sub-§8 is enacted to read:


8. Salary range changes. Except as otherwise provided in collective bargaining agreements or those reclassification requests which are subject to a contractually provided arbitration process, no salary range of any job classification or position in the unclassified service, including major policy-influencing positions, may be changed without the specific approval of the Legislature.'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires legislative approval of salary range changes in job classifications or positions in the unclassified services, unless provided otherwise by collective bargaining agreements.
