Amend the amendment in section 7 in that part designated
"§9601." in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the first line (page
3, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the following: "near"
and inserting in its place the following: 'within 1,000 feet of'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "§9601." in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the 2nd
line (page 3, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "near" and inserting in its place the following:
'within 1,000 feet of'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "§9601." in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the 2nd
line (page 3, line 49 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "near" and inserting in its place the following:
'within 1,000 feet of'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "§9601." in subsection 1 by inserting after paragraph
C a new blocked paragraph to read:

'For the purposes of this section, "power-driven equipment" means
vehicles, tools or other equipment with an internal combustion
engine, but does not include boat motors.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies provisions relating to illegal
operation of power-driven equipment without spark arresters.
