COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 91, L.D. 126, Bill, "An Act to Make Additional Allocations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1989"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7017, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 819, Pt. A, §17, is amended to read:

2. **Unencumbered balances.** Any unencumbered allocated balances, including existing balances, shall be carried forward into the next fiscal year and shall not be expended without allocation by the Legislature, except as provided in this section. Unencumbered balances in the boating access sites account shall be nonlapsing and shall be carried forward to be used for the same purpose.

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 8th line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Boating Access Sites'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment establishes a separate account for those funds which will not require a new allocation every year.
