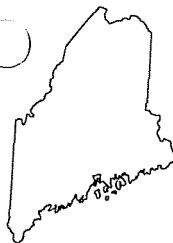

An Act to Provide a Sales Tax Exemption for Senior Citizen Organizations.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **36 MRSA §1760, sub-§65** is enacted to read:

5 65. Senior citizen organizations. Sales to incorporated,
7 nonprofit senior citizen organizations whose primary purpose is
to provide a program of activities for senior citizens.
