COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 104, L.D. 141, Bill, "An Act to Provide Credit for Braille Courses"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'20-A MRSA §4707 is enacted to read:

§4707. Instruction in Braille and Nemeth Code

Schools may offer instruction in Braille and Nemeth Code as part of the school curriculum. When Braille or Nemeth Code courses are offered, schools shall determine appropriate credit for completion of those courses.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that school units may offer Braille and Nemeth Code instruction as part of the school curriculum and that academic credit shall be offered for completion of those courses.
