HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 104, L.D. 141, Bill, "An Act to Provide Credit for Braille Courses"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4726, sub-§§2 and 3, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 178, are amended to read:

2. Encouraged to offer. Is encouraged to offer one or more additional foreign languages as part of its secondary school program; and

3. American sign language. May offer American sign language to fulfill the foreign language requirement under subsection 2; and'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the amending clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 2.'
