HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 108,
L.D. 145, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Recycling of Lead-acid
Batteries"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd
paragraphs (page 1, lines 20 to 28 in amendment) and inserting in
their place the following:

'Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1604." by
striking out all of subsection 1 (page 1, lines 11 to 23 in L.D.)
and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Disposal. No person may dispose of a lead-acid battery
by burial, incineration, deposit or dumping so that the battery
or any of its constituents may enter the environment or be
emitted into the air or discharged into any waters.'

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph, in
paragraph B, subparagraph (1), in the 2nd line (page 1, line 38
in amendment) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in
its place the following: '30'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects a technical problem in the original
committee amendment and to extend the trade-in period from 7 days
to 30 days. It is further the intent of the Legislature that the
sale of products which coincidentally contain lead-acid
batteries, such as cars and trucks, not be subject to the
provisions of this Act.
