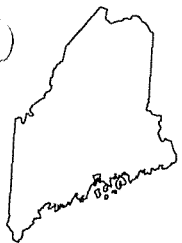

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Make Supplemental Allocations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990 and June 30, 1991.

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
3 as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the
6 beginning of the next fiscal year; and

7
8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
9 operation of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will
10 become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1989; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
13 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
15 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety; now, therefore,

17
18 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

19 **Sec. 1. Supplemental allocation of the Maine Endangered and**
20 **Nongame Wildlife Fund.** Income to the Maine Endangered and
21 Nongame Wildlife Fund for the fiscal years from July 1, 1989, to
22 June 30, 1990, and from July 1, 1990 to June 30, 1991, shall be
23 segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the
24 following schedule.

35 **Sec. 3. Adjustments to allocations.** Allocations may be increased
or adjusted by the State Budget Officer with the approval of the
Governor to make necessary adjustments under any salary plan
approved by the Legislature and reclassifications or range
changes approved by the Department of Administration and
submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of
this Act.

41 **Sec. 4. Encumbered balances at year end.** At the end of each
fiscal year, all encumbered balances shall not be carried forward
more than once.

45 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1989.
