An Act to Require a Permit to Hunt for Bear Prior to the Firearm Season on Deer.



3	12 MRSA §7110 is enacted to read:
5	§7110. Bear hunting permit
7	1. Issuance. The commissioner or the commissioner's authorized agent shall issue a bear hunting permit to any
9	applicant who possesses a valid license to hunt big game, permitting that person to hunt for bear from the first Monday
11	preceding September 1st to the day preceding the open firearm season on deer. The bear hunting permit shall be in the form of
13	a stamp which shall be affixed to the person's hunting license.
15	2. Fee. The fee for a bear hunting permit shall be \$10.25, 25¢ of which shall be retained by the issuing agent.
17	3. Validation. A bear hunting permit is validated by the permittee's signature in ink on the face of the stamp.
21	4. Restrictions. The following restrictions apply to bear hunting permits.
23	A. A bear hunting permit shall be exhibited to any warden
25	or employee of the department upon request.
27	B. From the first Monday preceding September 1st to the day preceding the open firearm season on deer, a permittee shall
29	keep an unexpired, validated bear hunting permit on the permittee's person when hunting or possessing any bear.
31	5. Exceptions. No bear hunting permit is required to hunt
33	for bear during the open firearm season on deer as defined in section 7001, subsection 25-A.

37	STATEMENT OF FACT
39	The establishment of special stamp and permit requirements
41	to hunt specific wildlife species is an important wildlife management tool. It provides a means of more accurately
43	monitoring hunting pressure, hunter success and the status of the wildlife population. It also provides a means of maintaining
45	harvests within acceptable limits if such action is warranted.
47	This bill establishes a special bear hunting permit in the form of a stamp which will be required of any person who hunts
49	for bear prior to the opening of the firearm season on deer. This permit will be required in addition to a regular hunting
51	license. It will generate additional revenue for the department while providing the information necessary to better manage the
