COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 122, L.D. 159, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Membership of the Emergency Enhanced 9-1-1 Telephone Advisory Committee"

Amend the bill in subsection 1 in the 2nd and 3rd line from the end (page 1, lines 45 and 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following underlined words: "one who is a physician, physician's assistant or nurse directly involved with emergency medicine" and inserting in their place the following: 'one dispatcher'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

It is anticipated that any additional costs as a result of this bill would be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the commission member who is either a physician, physician's assistant or nurse with a member who is a dispatcher. It also adds a fiscal note.
