The inspection fee is \$5 \$6 for each 2. 25 inspection and is payable whether the vehicle passes inspection or not. 27 Sec. 7. 29 MRSA §2518, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1985, c. 14, §1, is further amended to read: 29 31 Disposition of stickers. All inspection stickers and 1. materials issued to inspection stations by the Chief of the State Police shall remain the property of the State. Each official 33 inspection station shall stock a sufficient number of stickers to 35 meet their demands at all times. These shall be furnished by the Chief of the State Police at 50# <u>\$1</u> each. The stickers shall be 37 made of such material and quality of adhesive as prescribed by the Chief of the State Police.' 39 Further amend the amendment in section 14 in the first line (page 16, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: 41 "7" and inserting in its place the following: '9' 43 Further amend the amendment in section 14 by inserting at 45 the end the following new sentence: 'Sections 7 and 8 shall take effect 90 days after adjournment.' 47

9 If enacted, this bill would result in an increase in revenue to the Highway Fund in the amount of \$397,500 for fiscal year
11 1989-90 and \$530,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This revenue would be derived from the proposed increase in the motor vehicle
13 inspection fees.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment increases motor vehicle inspection fees in order to cover the shortfall in the highway budget.
