IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Make Supplemental Allocations from the Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990 and June 30, 1991.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

11 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 13 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 15 safety; now, therefore,

17 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

 Sec. 1. Supplemental allocations of Highway Fund. Income to the Highway Fund for the fiscal years from July 1, 1989 to June 30,
1990 and from July 1, 1990 to June 30, 1991 shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as designated in the following schedule:
