47	institutions of higher education and in vocational schools. In the general program the interest rates are subsidized by the
49	federal government, which collects an origination fee of 5% of the loan amount. This fee is not assessed for Parent Loans for
51	Undergraduate Students (PLUS) and for Supplementary Loans for Students (SLS) which do not have subsidized interest rates. In

addition, in all 3 cases, the State collects a guarantee fee of 3% of the loan amount to provide a reserve for defaults and other administrative expenses. These fees are deducted up front, so that the borrower receives less than the face value of the loan.

This bill prohibits the State from collecting such fees. A General Fund appropriation of \$1,000,000 is included to make up for the lost revenue. The federal fees would not be changed by this bill.
