IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend Certain Dates Relating to the County Budget Procedure.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30-A MRSA §701, sub-§§3 and 4, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C, §106, are amended to read:

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3. Public hearing. The county commissioner shall hold a 7 public hearing in the county on these estimates before December ist <u>31st</u>. They shall publish a notice of the hearing at least 109 days before the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the county. Written notice and a copy of the estimates 11 shall be sent by mail or delivered in person to the clerk of each municipality in the county and to each member of the county 13 legislative delegation at least 10 days before the hearing. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officers of the 15 receipt of the estimates.

Meeting with legislative delegation. Before the Legislature-convenes January 1st, the county commissioners of
each county shall meet with the legislative delegation of their county to finalize estimates for the year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to change the date on which 27 county commissioners must hold a public hearing on the budget and on which they must meet with the legislative delegation in order 29 to better coincide with the legislative session.
