An Act to Amend the Registration Process for Trailers.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	29 MRSA §106, first ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 789, §24, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

	Registration for all vehicles, except automobiles, newly
7	acquired motor trucks, truck tractors, motorcycles, mopeds and
	motor-driven cycles, shall expire annually on the last day of the
9	month, one year from the month of issuance. This section shall
	apply to motorcycles, mopeds and motor-driven cycles for
11	reregistration in 1989 only.

	The purpose of this bill is to have all trailer
17	registrations valid for one year from the month of actual registration.
