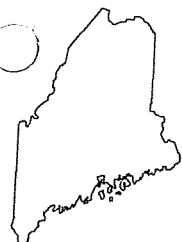

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Amend the Registration Process for Trailers.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **29 MRSA §106, first ¶**, as amended by PL 1987, c. 789, §24, is
5 repealed and the following enacted in its place:

7 Registration for all vehicles, except automobiles, newly
9 acquired motor trucks, truck tractors, motorcycles, mopeds and
11 motor-driven cycles, shall expire annually on the last day of the
13 month, one year from the month of issuance. This section shall
15 apply to motorcycles, mopeds and motor-driven cycles for
17 reregistration in 1989 only.

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 The purpose of this bill is to have all trailer
17 registrations valid for one year from the month of actual
registration.
