An Act to Require Driver's License Examinations for Persons 80 Years or Older.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	29 MRSA §545-C is enacted to read:
5	§545-C. Renewal of motor vehicle operator's licenses for persons 80 years of age or older
