An Act to Require Driver's License Examinations for Persons 80 Years
or Older.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **29 MRSA §545-C** is enacted to read:

5 **§545-C. Renewal of motor vehicle operator's licenses for persons**
7 **80 years of age or older**

9 **Any person who has attained that person's 80th birthday must**
11 **pass a driver's examination before that person's motor vehicle**
13 **operator's license may be renewed.**

13 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

15 **This bill mandates that persons 80 years of age or older**
17 **take and pass a driver's examination before their driver's**
license may be renewed.
