29	2-A. Freshwater wetland. "Freshwater wetland" means freshwater swamps, marshes, bogs and similar areas which are:
31 33	A. Inundated or saturated by surface or ground water at a frequency and for a duration sufficient to support, and which under normal circumstances do support, a prevalence of
35	wetland vegetation typically adapted for life in saturated soils; and
37 39	B. Not considered part of a great pond, coastal wetland, river, stream or brook.
41	These areas may contain small stream channels or inclusions of land that do not conform to the criteria of this subsection.
43	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §4404, sub-§14 is enacted to read:
45	14. Freshwater wetlands. All potential freshwater wetlands within the proposed subdivision have been identified on any maps
47	submitted as part of the application, regardless of the size of these wetlands. Any mapping of freshwater wetlands may be done
49	with the help of the local soil and water conservation district.'
