STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Relating to the Approval of School Administrative District Budgets.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §1308, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

§1308. Failure to pass budget

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If a budget for the operating of the district is not approved prior to July 1st, the budget as-submitted-by-the-board ef-directers of the previous year as approved pursuant to section 1304 or 1305 and as adjusted in any special budget meeting held pursuant to section 1309 shall be automatically considered the budget approved for operational expenses for the ensuing year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that if an operating budget is not approved, the previous year's budget as approved by the voters shall be used. If the previous year's budget is adjusted at a special budget meeting, the budget to be used shall include any changes made at the special budget meeting.
