COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 117, L.D. 183, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Coordinated Investigations of Complaints Regarding Special Education"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of the first line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §7206, sub-§§1-A and 1-B are enacted to read:'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by adding at the end the following:

'1-B. Notification. Within 15 days of the receipt of the complaint, the commissioner shall notify the affected school administrative unit or private school of the complaint and all information about the complaint which is available to the commissioner.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides for notification of the school involved when a complaint is filed with the Department of Educational and Cultural Services alleging that special education laws are not being complied with.
