13 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 123, L.D. 189, Bill, "An
15 Act to Exempt Speech and Hearing Centers from Home Health Care
Licensure"

17 Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 by adding at the
end the following: 'Beginning October 1, 1991, "home health care
19 provider" includes any business entity or subdivision thereof,
whether public or private, proprietary or nonprofit, which is
21 engaged in providing speech pathology services.'

23 Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 13 in the
first line (page 1, line 41 in L.D.) by striking the underlined
25 word "Agencies" and inserting in its place the following: 'Until
October 1, 1991, agencies'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

31 The original bill exempts speech and hearing centers from
licensure as home health care providers. This amendment permits
33 the exemption for 2 years and then reinstates the licensure
requirement.
