IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Concerning Motor Vehicle Registration Plate Design.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §131, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 725, Pt. H, §1, is amended to read:

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§131. Registration plate issues

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The Secretary of State shall provide a new general issue of registration plates every 6 years for all vehicles required to be registered in this State for operation on Maine highways. The first new general issue of registration plates shall commence on July-1,-1987 July 1, 1989, and successive new general issues of registration plates shall be issued every 6 years thereafter.

Each new general issue of registration plates as required by this section shall be easily distinguishable from the preceding general issue.

The-following-design-elements-are-guidelines-to-be-followed by-the-Secretary-of-State-in-the-production-of-new-plates-to-be issued-from-July-1987-to-December-1992.-A-new-plate-shall-have-a white--background, --identification -- numbers -- and -- letters -- and -- the border-shall-be-distinctly-navy-blue-in-color-with-any-graphic material-appearing-in-a-color-distinctly-lobster-red,-featuring an-illustration-of-a-lobster,-The-name-of-the-State-"Maine"-shall appear -- centered - at -- the -- top -- of -- the -- plate -- and -- the -- designation "Vacationland"-shall-appear-centered-at-the-bottom. Each county may develop and select its own design logo for new plates for citizens residing in that county. The delegation to the Legislature from each county shall determine the logo for that county and shall submit the design elements as guidelines to be followed by the Secretary of State in the production of new plates issued from July 1989 to December 1994. Notwithstanding any design logo selected by each county, each Maine resident may elect to receive plain plates having no distinguishing features other than the name of the State "Maine" appearing centered at the top of the plate and the designation "Vacationland" appearing centered at the bottom. This quidance is meant to be applied in accordance with the authority held by the Secretary of State in section 110.

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The Secretary of State shall adopt rules in accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, to implement this article. In these rules, the Secretary of State may include provisions to protect the integrity of the Maine motor vehicle registration plate, to provide for the issue of replacement plates and any other provisions to facilitate the implementation of this article.

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STATEMENT OF FACT
