An Act to Provide that Money Collected from Snowmobile Registration Fees be Returned to Registered Snowmobile Clubs.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **12 MRSA §7824, sub-§3, ¶A**, as amended by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt.
5 **C, §§23, 106**, is further amended to read:

7 **A.** The registration fee for residents shall be credited as
9 follows:

11 (1) \$4.75 of each fee shall be credited to the
13 department;

15 (2) \$5.25 of each fee shall be credited to the
17 Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Bureau of Parks and
19 Recreation; and

21 (3) \$6 of each fee shall be annually distributed to
23 the municipality of the owner's residence as shown on
25 his the owner's registration certificate, except that
27 in unorganized territory, \$6 of each fee shall be
29 annually distributed to the county of the owner's
31 residence as shown on his the owner's registration
33 certificate and credited to the unorganized territory
35 fund of that county established in Title 30-A, section
37 7502. Three dollars of each fee distributed annually
to each municipality shall be returned annually to any
registered snowmobile club in that municipality. If
there is more than one registered snowmobile club in
that municipality, the money shall be distributed
equally among those clubs.

33 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

35 This bill provides that 50% of the money collected from
37 snowmobile registration fees that is distributed annually to each
municipality is to be returned to all registered snowmobile clubs
in that municipality.
