1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	10 MRSA c. 204-A is enacted to read:
5	<u>CHAPTER 204-A</u>
7	MAINE COLLISION DAMAGE WAIVER ACT
9	<u>§1191. Title</u>
11	<u>This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Maine</u> <u>Collision Damage Waiver Act."</u>
13 15	<u>§1192. Scope</u>
17	This Act applies to all persons and organizations renting private passenger vehicles for no more than 30 days from locations in this State.
19	§1193. Definitions
21 23	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
25	1. Authorized driver. "Authorized driver" means:
27	A. The renter;
29	<u>B. The renter's spouse, if that person is a licensed driver</u> meeting the rental company's minimum age requirement;
31	C. The renter's employer or co-worker, if that person is
33	<u>engaged in business activity with the renter and is a licensed driver meeting the rental company's minimum age</u>
35	<u>requirement;</u>
37	D. A person who operates the vehicle during an emergency or while parking the vehicle in the course of that person's
39	employment at a commercial establishment; or
41	E. A person listed by the rental company on the rental agreement as an authorized driver.

45	2. Damage. "Damage" means any damage or loss to the rented vehicle, including loss of use and any expenses incident to the damage or loss.

	3. Private passenger vehicle. "Private passenger vehicle"
49	means a motor vehicle, including, but not limited to, an automobile, passenger van or minivan primarily intended for
51	transport of persons or a truck rented by a private,

- <u>4. Rental agreement. "Rental agreement" means a written</u>
 5 agreement setting forth the terms and conditions governing the use of a private passenger vehicle provided by a rental company.

- 5. Rental company. "Rental company" means any person or 9 organization in the business of providing private passenger vehicles to the public. 11
- 6. Renter. "Renter" means any person or organization 13 obtaining the use of a private passenger vehicle from a rental company under the terms of a rental agreement.

- <u>Authorized driver liability; exceptions.</u> In rental
 agreements of no more than 30 continuous days, a rental company
 shall not hold an authorized driver liable for any damage, except
 when:
- A. The damage is caused intentionally by an authorized driver or as a result of the driver's willful and wanton
 misconduct;
- B. The damage arises out of an authorized driver's operation of the vehicle while legally intoxicated or under
 the influence of any illegal drug as defined or determined under the law of the state where the damage occurred;
 - C. The damage is caused while the authorized driver is engaged in any speed contest regardless of whether the lawful speed limit is exceeded. Exceeding the lawful speed limit does not, by itself, constitute a speed contest;
- 37 D. The rental transaction is based on information supplied by the renter with the intent to defraud the rental company;
- E. The damage arises out of the use of the vehicle by an authorized driver while committing or otherwise engaged in a criminal act in which the automobile usage is substantially 43 related to the criminal activity excluding minor traffic violations;
- 47 F. The damage arises out of the use of the vehicle by an authorized driver to carry persons or property for hire; or
- 49 <u>G. The damage arises out of the use of the vehicle by an</u> <u>authorized driver outside of the United States or Canada</u>
 51 <u>unless this use is specifically authorized by the rental</u> <u>agreement.</u>

 Jurisdiction. An action for damage shall not be brought
 by a rental company against a renter who is a resident of the United States except in the county of the renter's primary
 residence.

7 <u>3. Deposit prohibited. A deposit in any form for damage</u>
 <u>shall not be required or requested by the rental company during</u>
 9⁻ <u>the rental period or pending resolution of any dispute.</u>

11 <u>4. Waiver. A waiver shall not be offered to provide</u> <u>coverage for any of the exceptions set out in subsection 1 or, if</u> 13 <u>applicable, a deductible.</u>

15 <u>§1195. Civil forfeiture; unfair trade practice violation</u>

17 <u>A person who engages in any act prohibited by this chapter</u> commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of at least
19 \$200, but not more than \$500, for the first offense and at least \$500, but no more than \$1,000, for each subsequent offense shall
21 <u>be adjudged. In addition to the civil penalty provided in this</u> section, a violation of this chapter constitutes a violation of
23 <u>Title 5, chapter 10.</u>

STATEMENT OF FACT

29 This bill prevents car rental companies from exploiting consumers renting vehicles for not more than 30 days by creating 31 a contractual liability for collision damage and then selling a waiver of liability for damage which, in most cases, the 33 consumer's personal automobile insurance already provides. This bill prohibits the rental company from holding the renter liable 35 for damage to a rented vehicle except under certain conditions.
