SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 152, L.D. 204, Bill, "An Act Making Allocations for the Expenditure of Funds Received by the State as a Result of Federal Court Orders in the Stripper Well Overcharge Case Involving the Shell Oil Company"

Amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph after the title by striking out the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 33 and 34 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

' Institutional Conservation Program '

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph after the title by striking out all of the 7th to 13th lines (page 1, lines 38 to 44 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Provides funds for grants to public and nonprofit schools and hospitals. Grants are not to exceed 50% of project costs for each facility. To the extent possible, these funds shall be used to assist public and nonprofit schools to convert from electric heat to other more economical heating sources.'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 3 by striking out all of the 14th to 22nd lines from the end of the amendment (page 4, lines 22 to 32 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

' Institutional Conservation Program '

All Other \$257,365

Allocates available balance from 2 programs

1 in order to fund grants to public and
2 nonprofit schools and hospitals. Grants are
3 not to exceed 50% of project costs for each
4 facility. To the extent possible, these
5 funds shall be used to assist public and
6 nonprofit schools to convert from electric
7 heat to other more economical heating
8 sources.'

16 ineligible for the program to which the funds were allocated.


