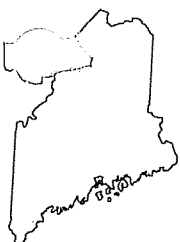

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An Act to Increase Funding of the Bureau of Maine's Elderly.

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**
