'Sec. 2. Edmund S. Muskie; special license plates. The Secretary of State shall issue one pair of specially designed license plates for one designated motor vehicle owned by Edmund S. Muskie of Kennebunkport. The plates shall be issued in his honor without charge for the lifetime of Edmund S. Muskie.

21 This amendment provides lifetime license plates to Edmund S.

Muskie as well as Margaret Chase Smith. There would be no
23 registration fees charged for the license plates, but the excise
tax would not be affected. The amendment also adds an emergency
25 preamble and emergency clause and a fiscal note.
