

**An Act to Amend the Law Concerning the Provision of Equipment and  
Clothing for Firefighters.**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §2103, sub-§10** is enacted to read:

5 10. Applicability. This section does not apply to any  
7 community with 7,500 or fewer residents.

9 **Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §2104, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

11 5. Applicability. This section does not apply to any  
13 community with 7,500 or fewer residents.

15 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

17 This bill exempts any community with a population of 7,500  
or under from the laws regarding standards for firefighting  
equipment and clothing.
