27	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:
29	'Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1084-A is enacted to read:

35	As a condition of renewal of a certificate to practice, a practitioner shall provide evidence of having successfully completed 40 hours of continuing education during the 2 years
37	prior to application for renewal. To gualify as meeting this
39	requirement, the education must relate to professional competency and relate to those aspects of the profession in which the
41	practitioner is currently engaged. The board shall specify the desired content of the program of continuing education, establish

The board and the practitioners shall follow and be bound by the 13 provisions of section 1084-A in the implementation of this 15 section.' 17 STATEMENT OF FACT 19 The original bill gave the Board of Dental Examiners 21 authority to promulgate rules in specific areas. 23 This amendment removes the provision giving such authority in the area of procedures and fees for application and renewal 25 and provides the board with specific statutory direction in the area of continuing education to guide its rulemaking. 27
