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An Act to Define and Clarify the Authority of the Board of Dental  
Examiners to Promulgate Rules.

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **32 MRSA §1073, sub-§2**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1983,  
5 c. 378, §6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

7 2. Rules. Adopt rules in accordance with the Maine  
9 Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, which are  
11 necessary for the implementation of this chapter. The rules may  
13 include, but need not be limited to, requirements for licensure,  
15 interviews for licensing and renewal, continuing education,  
17 inactive licensure status, use of general anesthesia and  
19 procedures and fees for application and renewal.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this bill is to enable the Board of Dental  
Examiners to adopt rules concerning interviews for licensing and  
renewal, continuing education, the inactive status of its  
licensees and the use of general anesthesia.
