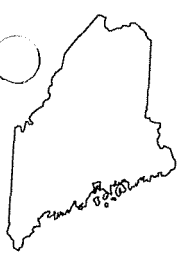

1       **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3               **36 MRSA §1760, sub-§65** is enacted to read:

5               65. Vietnam veteran registries. Sales to any incorporated
