IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Preserve Maine's Part-time Citizen Legislature by Making the Legislative Process More Efficient and Less Costly to Maine Taxpayers.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3 ·	3 MRSA §5 is enacted to read:
5	§5. Session procedure
7	Notwithstanding any rule of the Legislature, the following procedures apply to any regular session of the Legislature.

11	1. Friday sessions; limitation. During any regular session of the Legislature, the Legislature may not hold daily sessions on Fridays, except that daily sessions may be held on the last 4
13	Fridays of a regular session. This subsection does not prohibit any joint standing committee of the Legislature from holding a
15	hearing on a Friday.
17	2. After deadline bill requests. During any regular session of the Legislature, any bill request which is filed after
<b>1</b> 9	the cloture deadline must receive 8 votes of approval from the Legislative Council before that bill may be introduced.
21	3. Signature deadline. If a sponsor does not sign and
23	authorize the release of a bill request within 5 days of being notified by the Office of the Revisor of Statutes that the bill
25	is ready for signature, the bill may not be introduced unless it is introduced as an after deadline bill pursuant to subsection 2.
27	13 Incloduced as an after deadline bill pursuant to subsection 2.
29	STATEMENT OF FACT
31	This bill proposes to place several legislative procedures into the Maine Revised Statutes. Under this bill, the following
33	procedures apply in any regular session.
35	1. The Legislature will not have Friday sessions until the last 4 Fridays of the session.

39	2. After deadline bill requests require 8 rather than 6 votes of approval by the Legislative Council.
41	3. If a bill which is ready for signature is not signed or authorized for release by the sponsor within 5 days, the bill
