IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Concerning the Fishing of Smelt.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 12 MRSA §7171, sub-§4, ¶C, as amended by PL 1987, c. 317, 3 \$11, is further amended to read: 5 The following restrictions apply to the taking and с. 7 selling of live smelts under the smelt wholesaler's license. 9 (1)Any person engaged in taking, or assisting in taking, live smelts for resale from inland waters must hold a current smelt wholesaler's license which shall 11 be exhibited upon request to any agent of the commissioner. 13 15 The holder of a smelt wholesaler's license may use (2) a baitfish trap, a dipnet, a dropnet, a lift net, a bag net or hook and line to take live smelts for resale 17 from any inland water in accordance with general rules 19 promulgated by the commissioner in regard to the taking of smelts. 21 (3) The holder of a smelt wholesaler's license may use a-baitfish-trap,-a-dipnet,-a-dropnet,-a-lift-net,-a-bag 23 net-or-hook-and-line-to take up to 8 quarts of smelts in a 24-hour period, beginning at noon on any given 25 day, from specific inland waters designated by the commissioner. 27 29 (4) The holder of a smelt wholesaler's license may use particles of food for the purpose of luring smelts to a 31 baitfish trap, a dipnet, a dropnet, a lift net or a bag net. 33 (5) The holder of a smelt wholesaler's license may 35 transport or possess at his the wholesaler's business facility more than the daily bag limit of smelts at any 37 time, providing that the smelts were acquired in a lawful manner. If the smelts were purchased from 39 another person, a receipted invoice, bill of lading or bill of sale shall be presented upon request to any 41 this agent of the commissioner. For purposes of paragraph, live smelts shall be considered in 43 possession of the licensee once the smelts have been in a removed from the inland waters and placed 45 container. 47 (6) If a person sells live smelts from more than one wholesale facility, he <u>that person</u> must obtain a 49 separate license for each place of business. 51 The holder of a smelt wholesaler's license may (7)designate others to assist him that license holder in selling live smelts at his <u>that license holder's</u> business facility.

(8) The holder of a smelt wholesaler's license, or his
<u>that license holder's</u> designee, may transport live
smelts, except that live smelts being transported
directly from an inland water source must be
accompanied by the licensee.
