IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Expand the Circuit Breaker Program.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	36 MRSA §6207, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1987, c. 876, §§5 and 10, is further amended to read:
5	
7	1. Benefit calculation. For claimants representing a nonelderly household, the benefit is 50% of the amount by which the benefit base exceeds 4.5% <u>3%</u> of income to a maximum payment
9	of \$400.

15	The estimated fiscal impact of this legislation is an increase in program expenditures of \$10.9 million annually.
