IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Promote Thorough Consideration of Gubernatorial Appointments.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 MRSA §151, 3rd ¶ from the end, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 771, §11, is amended to read:

The committee shall recommend confirmation or denial by majority vote of committee members present and voting. The vote of the committee shall be taken only upon an affirmative motion to recommend confirmation of the nominee. A tie vote of the committee shall be considered a recommendation of denial. Such The vote shall be taken no later than 20 30 days from the date of the Governor's written notice of the nomination to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The committee vote shall be by the yeas and nays.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill extends the period during which a joint standing committee may consider gubernatorial appointments to 30 days.
