STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Prohibit Anyone from Hunting or Trapping on Land which Has Been Posted to Prohibit Hunting or Trapping.

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7377, sub-§9 is enacted to read:
5	9. Posted land. Nothing in this section may be construed to permit any person to hunt or trap on land that has been posted
7	in such a manner as to prohibit hunting or trapping.
9	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§21 is enacted to read:
11	21. Posted land. No person may hunt on land which has been posted in such a manner as to prohibit hunting.
13	Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7432, sub-§16 is enacted to read:
15	16. Posted land. No person may trap on land which has been
17	posted in such a manner as to prohibit trapping.
19	Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §7901, sub-§13 is enacted to read:
21	13. Hunting or trapping on posted land. A violation of section 7406, subsection 21 or of section 7432, subsection 16 is
23	a civil violation for which a forfeiture of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 for each day the violation is committed may be
25	adjudged, of which not more than \$40 may be suspended.

33	This bill prohibits anyone, including the owner of the land, from hunting or trapping on land which has been posted in such a manner as to prohibit that activity by others.
