19	The Chester Dental Clinic is now in its 18th year of serving residents of north-central Penobscot County. Since its
21	inception, the clinic has focused its services on dentally indigent children.
23	Until October 1, 1984, the Chester Dental Clinic was a part
25	of the National Health Services Corps Program. Due to recent cutbacks in financial support for the United States Public Health
27	Service in fiscal year 1989-90, the Chester Dental Clinic still needs \$24,000 in financial support in order to continue to offer
29	the same level of services to the approximately 1,000 patients it serves each year.
