An Act to Reinstate the Tax Exemption Related to Lottery Winnings.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §388**, as repealed by PL 1987, c. 546, is
reenacted to read:

5 **§388. Maine state income tax; prizes exempt**

7 The prizes received pursuant to this chapter shall be exempt
9 from the Maine state income tax.

11 **Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §423**, as repealed by PL 1987, c. 343, §2 is
reenacted to read:

13 **§423. State tax exemption**

15 The cash prizes received pursuant to this compact shall be
17 exempt from all state, county, municipal and local taxes within
19 the party state.

21 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

23 Section 1 of this bill reinstates the tax exemption for
25 Maine State Lottery prizes. Section 2 reinstates the tax
exemption for Tri-State Lottery prizes.
