29	FISCAL NOTE

33	It is anticipated that enactment of this bill would basically result in no net fiscal impact to the State for the biennium. Although the bill would result in an initial loss of
35	revenue from the elimination of the agent fee, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife has indicated that fewer and more
37	effective agents would reduce the cost of operation and offset the anticipated loss of dedicated revenue. It is anticipated
39	that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will absorb the cost of promulgating rules.'

43	STATEMENT OF FACT

47	This amendment requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to promulgate rules establishing criteria for the selection of agents to issue licenses and permits to
