21	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.
23	Further amend the bill in section 2, in paragraph C, in
25	subparagraph (9), in the 4th line (page 3, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>acquisition</u> " and inserting in its
27	place the following: ' <u>creation</u> '
29	Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 3 and 4.
31	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of
33	fact the following:
35	'Sec. 2. Planning Advisory Council report on recreation and open space lands. The Planning Advisory Council shall advise the
37	Office of Comprehensive Land Use Planning on issues and needs for municipalities regarding the acquisition and management of open
39	space and recreation lands. In addition, the council shall consider the need for developing within the office a program to
41	help municipalities acquire conservation easements and protect recreation and open space lands. The council shall report to the
43	Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources by March 15, 1990, its recommendations, including any necessary
45	implementing legislation. If the council establishes that there is a need for such a program, the report shall include
47	recommendations on the program's structure.

## **Fiscal Note**

This bill will add minor additional responsibilities to the Planning Advisory Council and the Office of Comprehensive Land Use Planning. The office has sufficient budgeted resources to implement this bill.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

15 This amendment reassigns the activities of the Maine Greenbelt Commission proposed under the original bill to the existing Planning Advisory Council. This 7-member group advises the Office of Comprehensive Land-Use Planning on the implementation of the growth management laws. The council is required to report on the need to help municipalities with open space acquisition and planning.

23 The amendment also replaces the word "acquisition" with "creation" in section 2, in recognition of the many methods 25 available to ensure the protection of open space areas in addition to acquisition. A fiscal note is added to reflect that 27 the office has sufficient budgeted resources to undertake this project.
