An Act to Allow the Town of Standish to Plow and Sand Certain Private Roads.

Sec. 2. Definitions. For the purpose of this Act, a private road is defined as a road which has never been accepted by the town's legislative body as a town way, private way or easement to which the general public has no legal right of access. A private way means a road which has been discontinued but for which there is an underlying public easement.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The Town of Standish has plowed and sanded certain private roads and ways for many years on which there were year-round residents. Approximately 2,000 citizens currently reside on private roads and ways and have petitioned the town council to continue its practice of funding the plowing and sanding.

The passage of this bill will authorize the continuation of plowing.
