13 15	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 187, L.D. 252, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Debt Limit for the South Berwick Water District"
17	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
19 21	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
23	as emergencies; and
25	Whereas, the South Berwick Water District needs the authority to increase their bonded indebtedness before the 90-day
27	period after adjournment has elapsed; and
29	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
31	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
33	Further amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the
35	first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'
37	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of
39	fact the following:
41	'Sec. 2. Referendum; emergency clause. This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of the Town of South Berwick at the
43	regular town meeting in 1989 or at a special town meeting to be called and held for the purpose within 90 days of the approval of
45	this Act. That special town meeting shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal
47	elections; provided, however, that the selectmen of the town shall not be required to prepare for posting, nor the town clerk
49	to post, a new list of voters and for the purpose of registration of voters the board of voters registration shall be in session on
51	the secular day next preceding the special election. The voters shall vote on the following question:

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A to H.P. 187, L.D. 252 1 "Shall the limit on the bonded indebtedness of the South 3 Berwick Water District be increased to \$4,000,000?" 5 This Act shall take effect when approved. Section 1 of this Act shall take effect when adopted by a majority of the legal 7 voters of the Town of South Berwick voting at the election.' 9 STATEMENT OF FACT 11 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause. It also adds the requirement of a vote at a town meeting. 13
