**An Act to Increase the Debt Limit for the South Berwick Water
District.**



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **P&SL 1959, c. 61, §11, first ¶,** as amended by P&SL 1981, c. 12,
5 **§7, is further amended to read:**

7 For accomplishing the purposes of this Act, and for such
9 other expenses as may be necessary for the carrying out of said
11 purposes, said district, through its trustees, without district
13 vote, is authorized to borrow money temporarily and to issue
15 therefor its negotiable notes; and for the purpose of renewing
17 and refunding the indebtedness so created, of paying any
19 necessary expenses and liabilities incurred under this Act,
21 including organizational and other necessary expenses and
23 liabilities whether incurred by the district or the town of South
25 Berwick, the district being authorized to reimburse said Town of
27 South Berwick for any such expense incurred by it and in
29 acquiring properties, paying damages, laying pipes, mains,
aqueducts and conduits, constructing, maintaining and operating a
water plants or system and making renewals, additions, extensions
and improvements to the same and to cover interest payments
during the period of construction, said district, through its
trustees, without district vote, is also authorized to issue,
from time to time, bonds, notes or other evidences of
indebtedness of the district in one series, or in separate
series, in such amount or amounts, bearing interest at such rate
or rates, and having such terms and provisions as the trustees
shall determine; provided the total indebtedness of the district
shall not exceed the sum of \$2,000,000 \$4,000,000.
