**Resolve, to Extend the Reporting Deadline for the Study of Low-level
Radioactive Waste in the Town of Greenbush.**

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
3 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

5 **Whereas,** this legislation is necessary so that the State
Geologist may report findings in a timely manner; and

7 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
9 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
11 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it

13 **Resolve 1987, c. 113, amended. Resolved:** That Resolve 1987, c.
15 113, the 2nd resolve paragraph, is amended to read:

17 **Report. Resolved:** That the University and the Town shall
issue a report on the findings to the Joint Standing Committee of
19 the Legislature on Energy and Natural Resources by January 15,
1989 1990; and be it further

21 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
23 preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
