COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 140, L.D. 260, Bill, "An Act Concerning Seafood Market Development"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for anticipated advertising and promotional expenses of the Marine Products Marketing Program.		

FISCAL NOTE

If enacted, this bill would:

1. Result in an increase in dedicated revenue to the Department of Marine Resources, Seafood Market Development, Account #04104.4, in the amount of \$1,500 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$5,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This revenue would be derived from anticipated contributions from seafood producers; and

Require an allocation of Other Special Revenue to the Department of Marine Resources, Seafood Market Development, Account #04104.4, in the amount of \$1,500 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$5,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This allocation would provide funds for anticipated advertising and promotional expenses.'
