COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 143, L.D. 263, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Annual Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund Assessment, Establish a Consumer Assistance Specialist Position and Make Certain Other Changes"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 to 3.

Further amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 1, in the 5th line (page 2, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$2,700,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$2,696,000' and in the 7th line (page 2, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$2,914,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$2,910,000'

Further amend the bill in section 6, under the caption "**PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION**" by striking out all of the 5th line (page 3, line 26 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Personal Services	\$31,000	\$34,000'
--------------------	----------	-----------

Further amend the bill in section 6, under the caption "**PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION**" by striking out all of the last line (page 3, line 40 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'TOTAL	\$310,000	\$524,000'
--------	-----------	------------

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill in the fiscal note by striking out all of the 4th line (page 4, line 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Regulatory Fund	\$310,000	\$524,000'
------------------	-----------	------------

This amendment eliminates the provisions making the administrative secretary to the chair an unclassified service position. It also reduces the amount needed for personal services by \$4,000 in each year of the budget.
